


1. ASADA | Anti-Doping Courses

This user guide contains simple steps to complete your course:

Level 1: Select login & create new account

- Note: whilst this course does not expire, you may, be requested to re-complete Level 1 (or equivalent) every 3 years.

Level 2: Log in using your ASADA E-Learning details

- Select **Level 2 Anti-Doping Course**
- This course will take approximately 15 minutes to complete & does not have a quiz.
- Once completed, print your certificate and submit to your team manager/general manager.

- o Note: this course expires December 31 and will need to be completed on an annual basis to reflect any changes.
